Visitor Guide and Rule Booklet

First Steps

1. All riders entering the West Moto Park riding grounds (**Park**) must abide by the Park Rules outlined herein (**Rules**). The Park staff reserve the right to refuse entry or remove any person from West Moto Park.
2. No rider may enter any track or unload any vehicles without firstly attending the reception office located at the entry to the Park and signing and completing the Rider Waiver (including the Guardian section, if appropriate) and signing these Rules and Safety Guidelines.

Safety Gear

3. No person may ride on any track at the Park unless wearing the following protective equipment and clothing:

Helmet

- (A) A correct fitting helmet showing an appropriate Standards Association of Australia label and which has a full visor covering the riders eyes.

Clothing

- (B) Clothing of materials acceptable to West Moto Park.

Footwear

- (C) Boots which must be either of a recognized motocross or dirt track type, constructed of leather, plastic or other similarly durable material or other fully enclosed footwear acceptable to West Moto Park.

Gloves

- (D) Gloves which are of Motocross variety or otherwise recognized motorcycle or motocross gloves

4. West Moto Park reserves the right to refuse entry to any person who does not possess any of these items to its satisfaction.
5. Every rider must ensure that all safety gear is worn at all times whilst riding on any track or in any pit stop at the Park. West Moto Park reserves the right to eject any person who does not comply with this rule.

Condition of motorcycles

6. It is the responsibility each rider to maintain their motor bikes, riding equipment and safety equipment in good working order whilst riding at West Moto Park.
7. West Moto Park reserves the right to inspect any motor bike, riding equipment or safety gear (including body protection equipment) and refuse such equipment to be used at West Moto Park if it forms the opinion that any such equipment poses a safety risk to the rider or any other person riding at West Moto Park.
8. All fuel required for a riders' motorbike must be supplied by the rider and must be held in a suitable sealed container. West Moto Park do not provide any fuel on site for sale or otherwise.
9. No fuel may be taken onto any track (other than the fuel in the motorbike tanks). All refueling must be undertaken in the designated areas.

Signs and markings

10. Riders must strictly adhere to all safety signs, speed restrictions, track directions or any other sign or direction given by West Moto Park.
11. Subject to Rule 12, if you are observed breaching any such signs, restrictions or directions, you will usually be given a total of 3 warnings, following which you will be asked to immediately leave the park. However, West Moto Park reserves the right to ask any person to leave the Park at anytime without having to give any reason.
12. If you are observed doing anything that West Moto Park regards as inherently dangerous or negligent so as to risk yourself or other riders, you will be asked to leave the Park immediately.
13. All tracks in the Park are one way and will be sign posted as such. No short cuts.
14. The Park is open during the day light hours ONLY. Riders will not be permitted to ride at night. The times for returning motorbikes to the pits will be provided to you by Park staff upon arrival.

Children

15. Children under the age of 18 must be supervised by their guardian (as specified in the Rider Waiver) or another supervising adult at all times whilst in the Park.
16. All guardians and supervising adults will be responsible for the tracks that are used by those children under their supervision.

Camping

17. Persons camping at the park must sign in at administration and fill out the necessary details. You will be required to sign out following your stay at the grounds.
18. Tents of temporary structure will be accepted only, and campers may only set up in the designated camping areas. Anyone found camping outside this area will be asked to leave.
19. Please place all rubbish in the bins located around the camping grounds. Anyone found littering will be asked to leave the Park immediately.
20. Fires are permitted only in the camping grounds and will not be permitted in prohibited burning seasons.
21. The consumption of alcohol and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited at West Moto Park and will not be tolerated in any way whatsoever. Anyone found consuming or in possession of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave immediately.
22. Excessive noise will not be tolerated. Please respect the other campers.

Miscellaneous

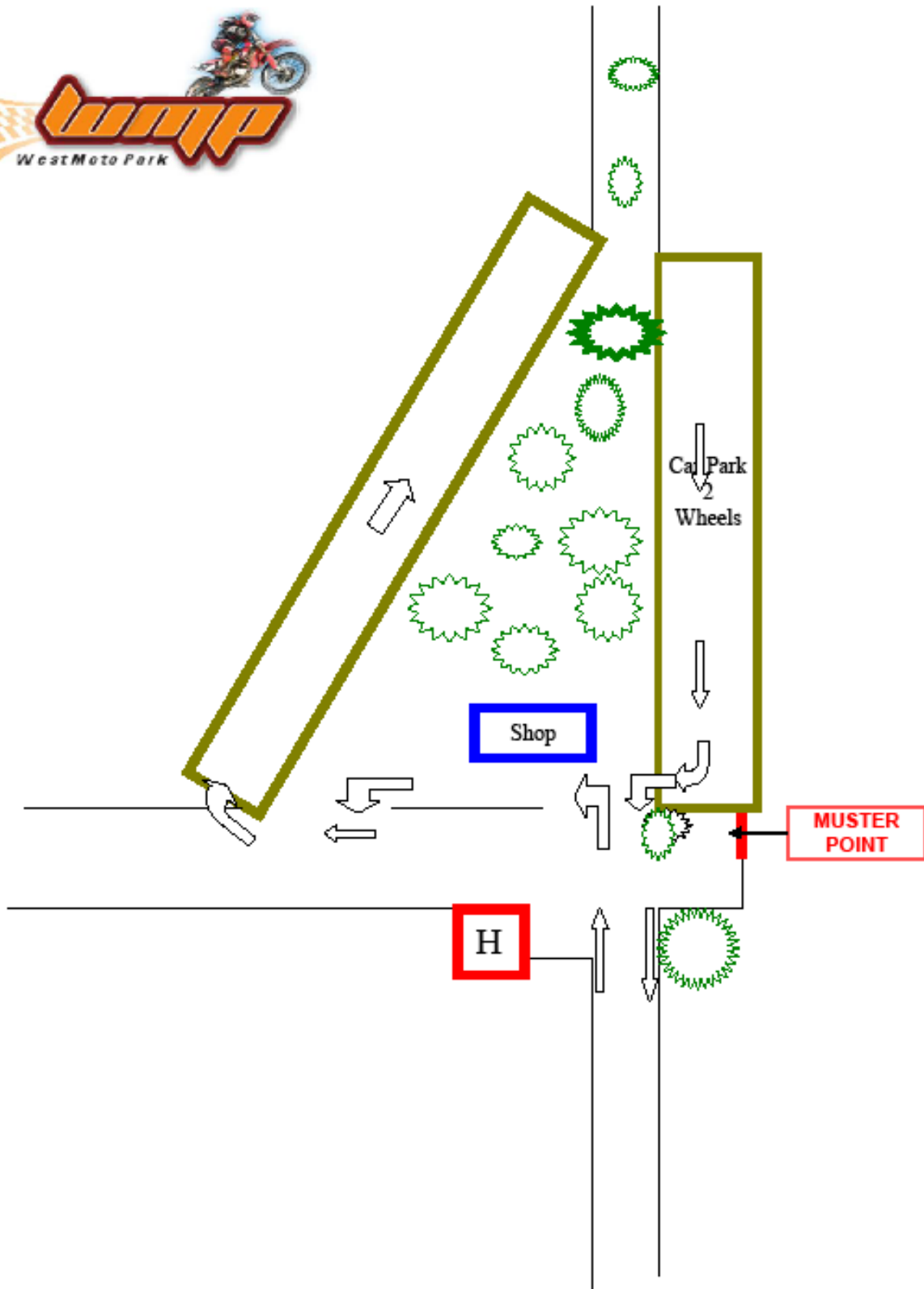
23. Apart from guide dogs, West Moto Park does not allow pets in the Park.

General Information

Below is a list of general bits and pieces to make your West Moto Park adventure a little easier.

1. RIDING HOURS are **8 AM** to **5 PM**
2. **All** issues you may have with the tracks or facilities should be reported to a safety officer, Justin or Steve immediately.
3. All water at the park is drinkable.
4. West Moto Park generates their own power and as such is switched off between the hours of **10 PM** and **8 AM**.
5. Hot showers are **ONLY** available between 8 AM and 10 PM.
6. No fires are allowed between the 1st of October and the 30th March every year.
7. Please help to keep our natural bushland the way it is, this means putting **all** litter into the bins provided ~ **INCLUDING** cigarette butts.

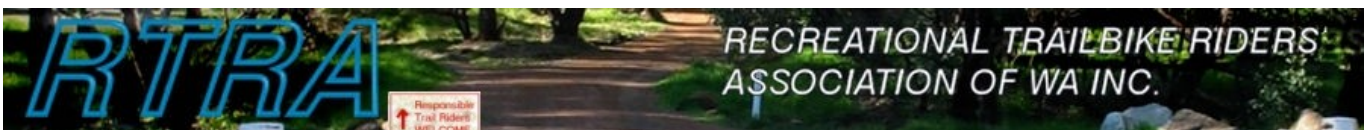
